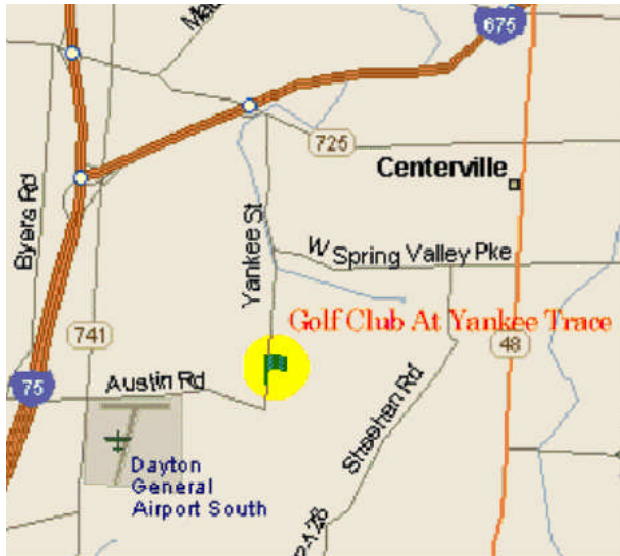

FROM COLUMBUS:

- ♦ I-70 West to Exit 44 (675 South, Cincinnati) South on I-675 to Exit 2 (route 725, Miamisburg-Centerville Rd)
- ♦ At exit stop light turn left across overpass to first traffic light
- ♦ Go straight through light on Yankee Street 2 miles to The Golf Club at Yankee Trace on the left
